### Audition

(Required for: Acting for Film & TV)

2 audition pieces required

Contrasting monologues (must be from a play), 1 contemporary and 1 Shakespeare, or 2 Contemporary (1 dramatic and 1 comedic). Each piece should be no longer than 2 minutes; the applicant should know both monologues without the use of text (on paper or computer). Audition can be done in-person, over Zoom, or pre-recorded and submitted as a video file (through WeTransfer).

Note: Portfolios/Auditions are *not* required for admission into our Web Development & Design or Art Foundation programs. If you have a diploma or degree related to the program you are applying for, a portfolio or audition is also not required. You have satisfied that requirement with your previous post-secondary education.

### 2 Letter of Intent

This is a one-page personal statement that answers the following questions:

What is your educational and/or work background?

What are your career goals and what are you passionate about?

Why have you chosen this specific program at VanArts?

### 3 Photo ID

Photocopy of government issued ID (e.g. passport, driver's license) to confirm date of birth & citizenship.

### 4 English Proficiency
